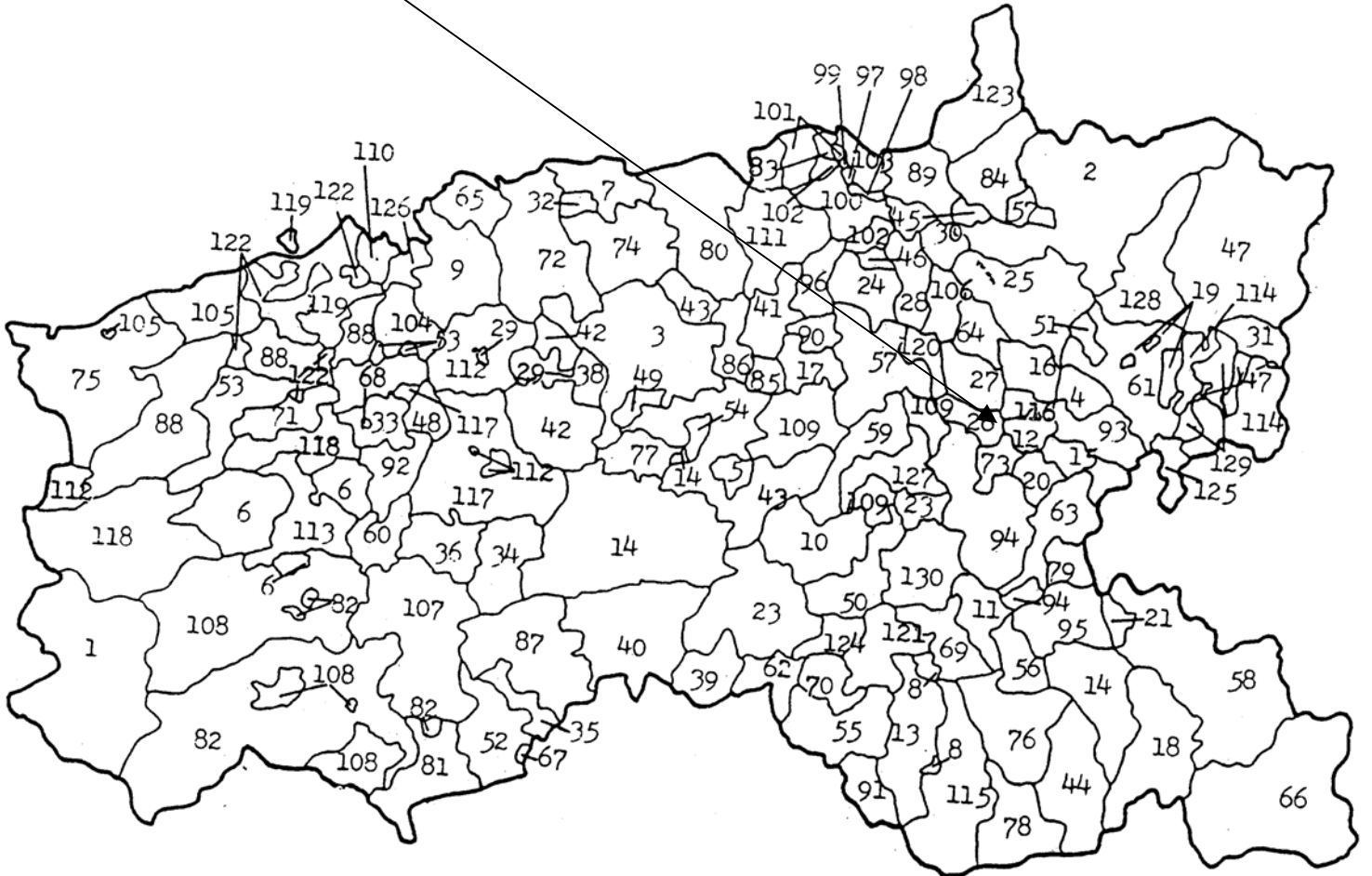

The property of Gabbetts Minors, Strand, Limerick, containing 505 a. 2 r. 33 p., including about 12 acres of rough pasture; the remainder arable land.		
In the W. boundary of this td. is Herbertstown Village. There are two Trigl. Stations, one in the N. of the td. Called Ballinard, and the other in the S. called Ballinard No. 2. There is also a burial ground in the S. of the townland.
