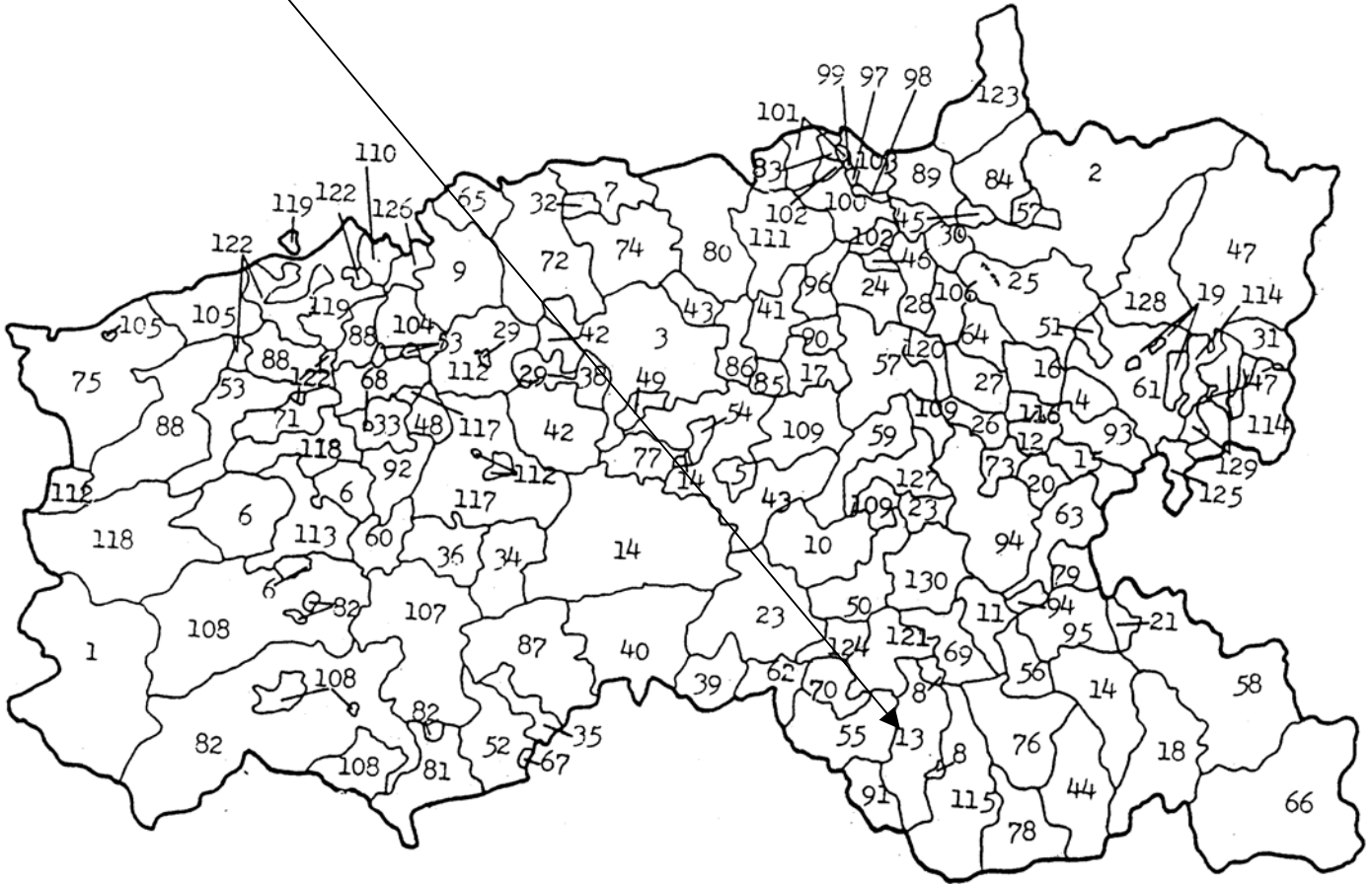

Bounded on the N. and W. by the Liberties of Kilmallock in the parishes of St. Peter and St. Paul and the parish of Effin; on the E. by the parishes of Kilbreedy Major and Particles; and on the S. by the parishes of Kilquaan and Particles.

Contains 5999 a. 2 r. 39 p. statute measure. The whole is arable, well cultivated, with the exception of some small portions of rough pasture. There are roads leading through the parish in all directions. There are a few small streams interspersed through the parish, also a few ancient forts. The residence of Mr. Coote of Mount Coote is situated in the N. of the parish. The highest part of the parish is south of Coombs Townland, being 1146 feet above the sea.

The road from Kilmallock to Kilfinnan passes nearly N. & S. across the West part of the td., and from this road another bears W. The N.E. boundary is the centre of a river.
