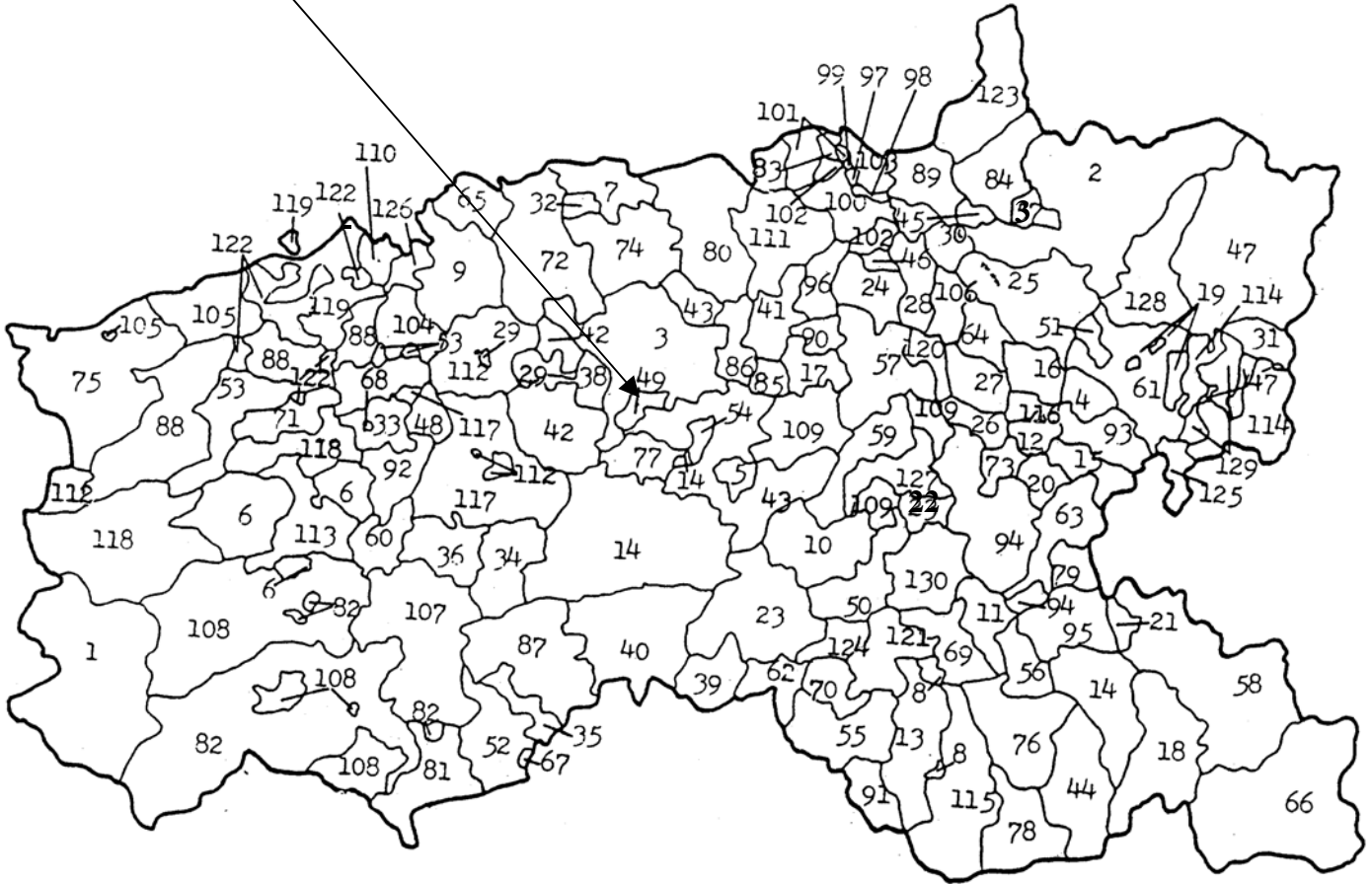

This parish is of an irregular form. Its greatest length from Drehidtrasna in the N. to Finniterstown in the S. is $1\frac{1}{4}$ mile, and its greatest width from E. to W. is about the same. Of its area, in the Barony of Conneello are 455 acres, and in the Barony of Coshma 545 acres, statute measure.

Situated in the E. of the parish, and contains 270 a. 2 r. 19 p. statute measure. Barony of Coshma. .

Beabus (contd.)

The property of Lord George Quin, England; Agent, Thos. Disney, Junior, Dublin. Let to 9 tenants, 2 of whom have leases of 3 lives, and 7 are tenants at will. Rent from £2 to £2 5s. per acre. Co. Cess per acre from 2s.6d to 3s.6d. Tithe per acre 2s. 7d. Size of farms - from 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 42 acres. Soil argillaceous, producing wheat, oats, and potatoes. Fuel scarce. Prevailing Names - Spearing and Power. There is a school here, containing 30 boys and 20 girls, all protestants, established in 1836. Teacher paid by the Revd, Rich. Maunsell. There is a small Corn Mill here.

Situated in the S. of the parish, and contains 16 a. 0 r. 25 p. st. measure. Barony of Connello Upper.

The property of Anthony Butler St. Leger, Westminster. Agent, Pelham Babbington, Esqr., Arthurstown, Co. Wexford. Let to 9 tenants, 3 of whom have leases of 21 years, and 6 are tenants at will. Rent from 15s. to 30s. per acre. Co. Cess per acre yearly from 2s.8d. to 3s.6d. Tithe per acre 2s. to 3s.7d. Size of farms - 6 to 40 acres plantation. Soil light and gravelly, producing wheat, oats, & potatoes. Prevailing Names - O'Doherty and Sullivan.

Drehidtrasna -- B. S. S. M. 4

Situated in the N. of the parish, and contains 244 a. 1 r. 27 p. st. measure. Barony of Coshma.

The property of Major Sullivan. Let to Sir David Roche, Caherass, on a lease of lives renewable for ever, at £1 per acre. Agent to Sir David, James O'Shaughnessy; Middleman holds a part and sublets the remainder to Dulcibella Rose, Victoria Terrace, Limerick, on a lease of 3 lives, at £2 5s. per acre. Co. Cess yearly from 2s.6d. to 3s.6d. per acre. Tithe free. Size of farms - 32 to 118 acres. Soil loamy, producing wheat, oats and potatoes. Prevailing Names - McNamara and Sullivan. There is a Protestant Church here, capable of accomodating 100 persons, built in 1812.

Finneterstown -- B. S. S. M. 5

Baile Flitéara, as pronounced corruptly in Irish by the inhabitants. The real name of the family was Ferriter; there was another branch of the family in West Kerry.

Situated in the S. of the parish, and contains 438 a. 3 r. 31 p. st. measure. Bary. of Connello Upper.

The property of Anthony Butler St. Leger. Agent, Pelham Babbington, Arthurstown, Co. Wexford. Let to 7 tenants, 4 of whom have leases of 21 and 3 are tenants at will. Rent from 15s. to 30s. per acre. Co. Cess per acre yearly from 2s.6d. to 3s.6d. Size of farms from 6 to 40 acres. Soil light and gravelly, producing wheat, oats and potatoes. Fuel scarce. Prevailing Names - Hogan and Hartigan.

Situated in the S. of the parish, and contains 30 a. 1 r. 8 p. st. measure. Bary. of Coshma.

The property of Lord George Quin, England. Agent, Thomas Disney, Junr., Esq., Dublin. Let to the Revd. Rich Maunsell during his life at £22 for the townland. Co. Cess 2s.6d. to 3s.6d. per acre yearly. Tithe, 19s.6d. Soil heavy, producing wheat, oats and potatoes. Fuel scarce. Prevailing Names - O'Dea and Maunsell. There is a Glebe House here.

Glebe House of Drehidtrasna 7

See parish name. J. O'D.

Situated in the td. of Glebe of Drehidtrasna.

This house was built in 1816, and is occupied by the Revd. Rich. Maunsell. It is 3 stories high, in good repair. Attached are a garden and a good set of offices.

Drehidtrasna Church and Graveyard 8

Situated in the td. of Drehidtrasna. Bary. of Coshma.

This is a small church, erected in the year 1812, capable of accomodating about 100 persons. Annexed to it is a burying place for Catholics and Protestants.

End of Drehidtrasna Parish
