This townland is in the N. extremity of the parish. It is bounded on the North, East and West by the ph. of Croom, and on the South by the ph. of Croom and the td. of Carrigeen.

It is the property of Trinity College, Dublin, containing 237 acres of demesne.

### Carrigeen

This townland is situated in the S. extremity of the parish. It is bounded on the E. and S. by the ph. of Croom; W. by the phs. of Ballingarry and Kilfinny; and N. by the ph. of Croom and the td. of Ballyouragan.

It is the property of the Earl of Dunraven, Adare, and contains 673<sup>±</sup> acres, all arable land. In the south of this td. is a Trigl. Station, called Carrigeen. In the North is another station, called Ballynahow. About the north-central part of the townland are Dysert Round Tower and Dysert Old Church in ruins.
