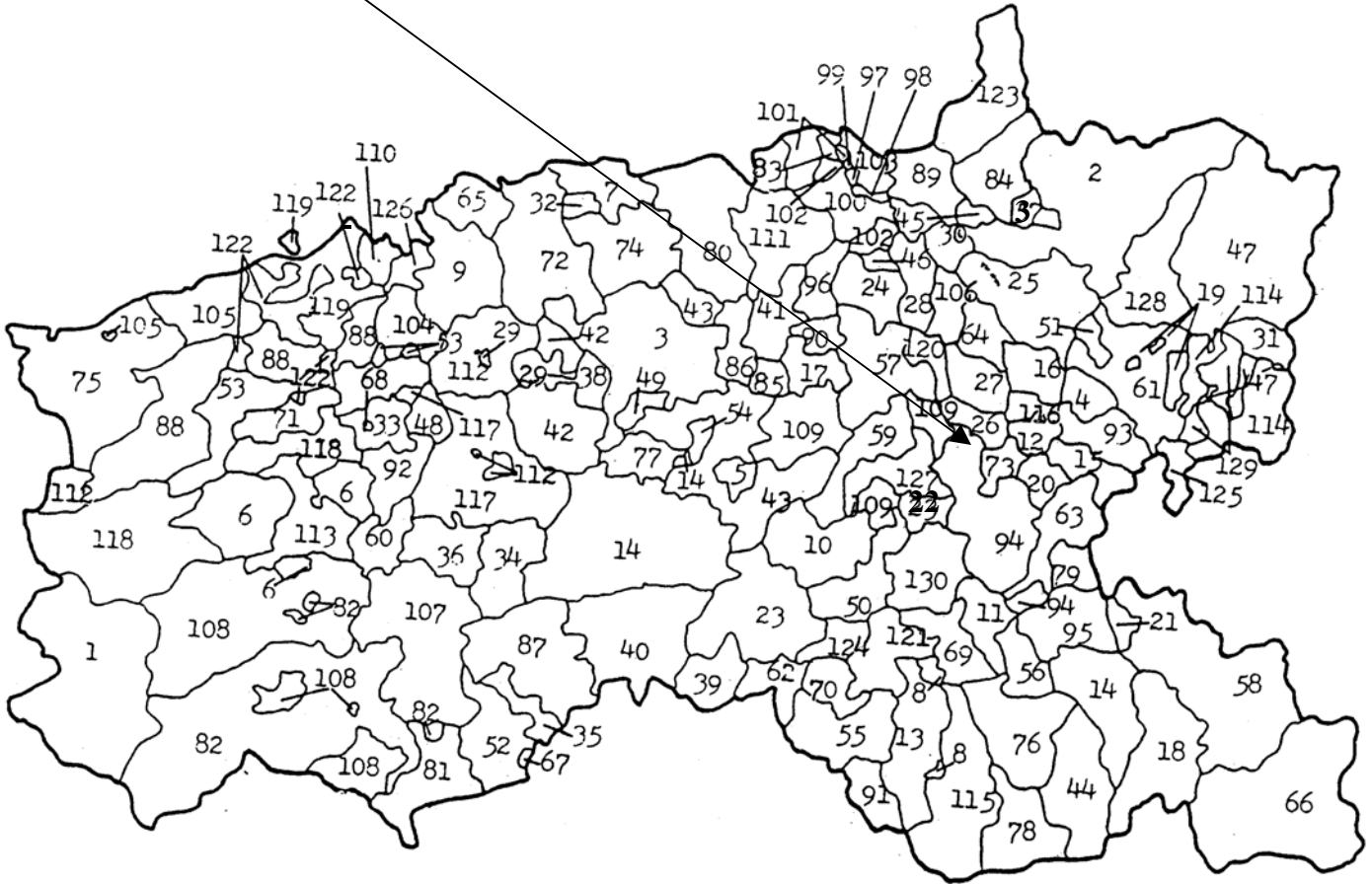

The property of John O'Grady, Esq., Kilballyowen, containing 163 statute acres. Herbertstown Village is on the east boundary of this townland. A portion of the west of the td. is liable to floods.

The property of Lord Gilmore, Rockbarton, containing 725 statute acres, including about 37 acres of bog. A portion of the east end of the townland is subject to floods. There are a Church ruins and a burial ground as well as Kilcullane House in the E. end of this td. Kilcullane Trigl. Station is in the central part, and a moat is in the E. end. of the td.
