Bounded on the N. by the phs. of Dromin, Uregar & Kilbreedy Hajor; W. by the phs. of Enkardstown and Kilbreedy Minor; E. by the phs. of Kilbreedy Major, Kilquane and Ballingaddy; and S. by the phs. of Kilbreedy Minor and Effin.

This parish took its name from an old Abley, founded by St. Mocheallog or St. Molach in the beginning of the 7th century. It contains 4,077 acres, statute measure, the whole arable land, well cultivated. In the E. of the parish there is a compact town, called Milmallock, which contains a great many ancient buildings. The leading road from Cork to Limerick passes from M. to S. through the parish, running through Milmallock Town, and several other roads branch in all directions. There are some ancient forts interspersed throughout the td. S.W. of Milmallock Town, there is a lough and a Sentlemen's demessne.
