Situated in the N. of the Barony of Shanid, on the south bank of the River Shannon. It contains 1.324 statute scres.

It is of a rectangular form. Its greatest length from N. to S. is 2 statute miles, and its greatest width from E. to W. is 18 statute miles. According to Fitzgerald. it is a Rectory in the Diocese of Limerick. It is bounded on the N. by the R. Shannon: S. by Lismakeery Ph.: E. by Askeaton Ph.: and W. by the phs. of Morgans and Robertstown.

Size of farms, 8 to 52 sores. Soil argillaceous, producing wheat, osts and potatoes. Fuel scarce. Frevailing Names: Hayes and Bridgeman. There are 3 forts in this townland.

The property of Mr. Murphy, Cork. Let to 4 tenants on a lease of years at from 60s. to 75s. per acre. Co. Cess per acre yearly 2s. to 3s. Tithe withheld. Soil loam, producing wheat, oats and potatoes. Frevailing Names: Mackahon. There is one large earthen fort in this townlend, about 5 chains in diameter.

## Toomdeely Castle (ruins) -- David Fitzgerald

Situated in the east side of the td. of Tomdeely H.
This old eastle is situated a little to the south of
the Church ruins. The wells are perfect with the exception of one fragment that has fallen from the top.
The eastle can be ascended by a spiral staircase. It is
of rectangular form, about 72 ft. long and about 40 ft.
broad.

Situated in the east of the td. of Tomdeely N.

A rectangular building, about 66 ft. long and about 20 ft. broad. The walls are in a good state of preservation.
