SITUATION. This Parish is in the Barony of Coshma and bounded on all sides by the Parish of Croom.

NAME. The name of this Parish is pronounced in Irish as if written Aithnid, but its meaning is not obvious.

There are no remains of antiquity in this Parish but a grave yard situated in the Townland of Anhid East, in which the old Parish Church stood, but there is nothing remarkable to be seen about it.
