## DREHIDTARSNA PARISH.

SITUATION. This Parish is situated in the Barony of Coshma and in the Barony of Connello Upper.

NAME. Drehidtarsna is pronounced in Irish Droichid. Tharsna, which signifies the Cross-Bridge.

There are no Church ruins found in this Parish. There is a Parish Church and there was, it may be supposed, an old 253

one formerly in the Churchyard where it stands. No traces of one, however, can be discovered. The Church and Church yard are situated on high ground.

The "Liber Regalis Visitationis" places Drehidtarsna in **254** the Deanery of Adaire and says:-

Drehidtarsnie - Rectoria Spectat ad praebenda Sancti Munchini - Vicaria vacat valor 30s.
