

KILFRUSH PARISH.

SITUATION. This Parish is situated in the Barony of Small County and is bounded on the north and west by the Parish of Hospital; on the south by the Parish of Knocklong and on the east by the Co. of Tipperary.

NAME. The Irish name of this Parish is Cill Fhuils, which signifies - - - - ?

There are no old Church ruins in this Parish; an old grave yard where there were, some time ago, some remains of an old Church observable is situated in the Demesne of Mr. Gabbins. This grave yard is not much in use. Some large old ash trees stand in it.

About three hundred yards to the west of it is situated a well called Tobar Choimáin, Saint Colman's Well, which is frequented on Saturday evening, particularly by persons labouring under diseases that affect the eye. Two ash trees stand over it.
