THE LABOUR LEAGUE COUNTY ORGANISING COMMITTEE MEETING AT RONDOROUGH RECENT INCREASE TO ROAD WORKERS

LIMERICK TRADES COUNCIL Socialistic Taint Discussed PROTEST AGAINST PAPER RESTRICTIONS Very Rev. Dr. Hackett Congratulated

At the last meeting of the Limerick Trades and Labour Council, Mr. P. O'Connor, B.C., in the motion of Mr. G. O'Connell, seconded by Mr. James Casey, took the chair in the unavoidable absence of the President, Mr. Joseph Hackett, who was engaged at the time of the meeting.

At the monthly meeting of the above Division of the L.O.H. on Sunday, the 14th inst., Mr. P. O'Sullivan presiding, two new members were proposed, and a resolution was unanimously adopted regarding the same.
