DEFINITION OF MOTOR CAR.

The expression "Motor Car" means a carriage propelled by Mechanical Power, and includes a Motor Bicycles or Triocycles, but does not include a vehicle drawn by a Motor Car, Motor Omnibus or other Vehicle being a Hackney Carriage within the meaning of Section 2 of the Customs and Excise Revenue Act, 1888, nor any Motor Cycle or Motor Vehicle.

LIMERICK COUNTY COUNCIL.

THE Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland.

ANIMALS IN CALF OR IN PIG NOT TO BE SLAUGHTERED OR EXPORTED.

1. An animal which is visibly or obviously in calf or in pig shall not (a) be slaughtered, or be caused or permitted by its owner to be slaughtered, or (b) be moved out of Ireland, or be caused or permitted by its owner to be moved out of Ireland.

EXCEPTIONS FROM RESTRICTIONS.—The restrictions imposed by the foregoing Articles shall not apply to—(a) slaughter of an animal under the powers conferred by the provisions of the Act, 1915, or any Statute in that behalf made, or (b) slaughter of an animal necessary or desirable on account of accidental injury to the animal or its illness, or (c) slaughter or movement of an animal, or slaughter or movement of an animal, authorized by a licence granted by the Department or officer of the Department.

2. Any Veterinary Inspector of the Department or subject to the direction of the Department, any Inspector of a Local Authority may cause the slaughter or movement of an animal, or slaughter or movement of an animal, which animals are slaughtered for human food and examine any animals or carcasses therein.

3. This Order applies to Ireland.

4. The Slaughter of Animals (Ireland) Order of 1915 is hereby revoked.

5. This Order applies to Ireland.

6. In this Order "the Department" means the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland, or any Statute in that behalf made, or any Statute in that behalf made.

7. This Order shall come into operation on the first day of September, Nineteen hundred and fifteen.

8. This Order may be cited as the MAINTENANCE OF LIVESTOCK (IRELAND) ORDER OF 1915.
