for the delay of a measure that is now well known was intended this year, is the almost unfurmountable difficulties that have prefented themfelves to the Minifters on the other fide of the water in the preparation of this arduous bufinels.

England never incurred a fingle debt, during all the wars fhe carried on, till the reign of William the Third, though their naval and military preparations were very great in the time of Elizabeth, in the wars afterwards with the Dutch, and those carried on during the Protectorate of Oliver Cromwell. After the Revolution, the funding fcheme was ftruck out and adopted, not only for the purpole of carrying on expensive Continental wars, but alfo to enfore the loyalty of the people, who, by a change of government, and the confusion attending, would run the hazard of lonng what they had lent on the public fecurity. The French immediately purfued the fame mode, but the credit of the Court of Verfailles was foon hurt by fome unfair proceedings of Louis the Fourteenth. It is however remarkable, that though the national debt of France is not near fo great as that of Britain, the annual interest of both is nevertheless pretty nearly alike, and almost fimilar methods are now ofing by the Ministers of each country to reduce those heavy and oppreflive incumprances,

It was the great capital and low intereft on oney, that fecured to Holland for fuch a ngth of time the carrying trade of the Euroan nations, for while money could be proted at four per cent. by the Dutch merchants, but the middle of the laft century, it was ht in England, ten in Ireland, and proporhably great in every other country. The tifh legiflature found the good policy of ucing it twice in Queen Anne's reign, till vas at length brought to the prefent flandard, nd the lrith Parliament followed the example. The States of Holland lowered theirs to three. but their carrying trade is at prefent very inconfiderable, as each nation has to greatly increaled their fhipping. As a ftriking proof of the vaft augmentation of wealth in England to what it had been four centuries fince, the lews and Lombards lent their money at from twenty to thirty per cent, and the revenues of the Kings did not exceed thirty-fix thousand per annum, till the time of Edward the Second. The British Savereigns are now dependant on the Parliament, but formerly they had their Royal demeines.
