GENTLEMEN,

THE Important Question to what extent the Constitution will admit, further indulgence to our Roman Catholic fellow subjects, having been introduced into the House of Commons, we feel our class now called upon, however we might have passed over the numerous exceptionable publications on the subject, to entreat you for the benefit of the Empire at large, but this Kingdom in particular, you will exert yourfelves, in relifting any attempt that may be made to injure, either immediately or in its confequences, the Protestant Establishment in Church or State.
