

Extract of a letter from Cork, March 31:

"Yesterday a boat crossing the Lake of Killarney was overset, and two men drowned.—The weather was very stormy, and the Lake much agitated, which prevented any timely assistance being given."

Saturday night our Assizes ended, when John Sheehan and Maurice Nunan, for a burglary and felony in the dwelling house of Thomas Murphy, at High-mount, in the Co. Limerick, received sentence to be hanged at gallows-green, this day, which was accordingly put in execution.—John Feheen, alias the Burning Boy, and William Shanahan, for a burglary and felony in the dwelling house of David Barry, of Ballynarouga, to be hanged on Saturday next the 7th April, at Ballingarry.

This day, Thomas Sheehan convicted of felony, was whipped from John's-gate to Thomond-gate; he is to undergo the like punishment on this day month, and then be discharged.

Catherine M'Cleary, otherwise Clarke, stood in the pillory this day, at the New Bridge, for attempting to poison Edward Thompson, she is to be again twice pillored.
