On Wednesday last William Collins, Esq, one of the Magistrates of the Co. of Limerick, paid to the Treasurer of the House of Industry 7l. 10s. being fines inflicted by him on Gentlemen, for killing Game contrary to Law.

We have authority to mention, that a plan is formed for establishing in this City, a Friendly Society, upon a scale which will include all such industrious people for miles round, who chuse by subscribing a few shillings upon entrance, and a small monthly pittance while in health, to secure for life a weekly subsistence, if disabled from earning their bread but shortly after, as well as a subscription for their family when they die.—This Society having the sanction of Parliament, has thereby many advantages, among others, the most perfect security against the mismanagement or failure of its fund; it will be open alike to all religious trades, and honest callings, except menial servants who are otherwise provided for when sick, and could not be visited then by order of the Society; and it will be managed by some of the principal employers in the City. It is further intended, if the liberality of the Public by their subscriptions will admit of it, to unite to this Society, the benefit of a charitable loan, by advancing small sums to certain members of it, interest free, payable by instalments upon security.
