Saturday's Gazette contains an official account
from Admiral Kingmill, of the taking of La
Victorine French privateer, of 16 guns, and 80
men, by the Santa Margarita—(mentioned in a
former paper).—Also of the capture two Dutch
and one French privateer.

The Brig Mary, of Exeter, laden with 2500
Casks and Firkins of Butter, that sailed from
hence the 17th inst. for London, has been taken
by three French Privateers off Cape Clear, and
sent for France.—Two of the Privateers has been
since taken by his Majesty's Ships Dryad and
Penguin, and sent into Cove.

It is much to be feared, that the Brig Daphne,
that sailed from hence the same Day, with But-
ter, &c. for London, has been also taken by one
of the above Privateers.
