Extract of a Letter from Mitchelstown, dated
 Dec. 16, 1797.

"There was a disagreeable affair happened
 in Kilworth last Friday noon. Col. Fitzgerald had intimated that Lady Mary W.
 had been brought to the Castle here, in conse-
 quence of which he came in pursuit of her, per-
 ceived by the name of Ford, and was two days in
 this town; there was not a foot of this distance
 or of Moore-Park, that he did not walk over.—
 The E. of K. followed him to Kilworth,
 and had the door of the room in which he lay
 lay, at Simpson's, burst open, fired at him, and
 lodged the contents of a loaded pistol in his
 heart. There was an inquest held on him yester-
 day, the verdict was, "that he was shot by
 a pistol loaded with powder and ball, and fired
 by the hand of the E. of K." The in-
 quire this morning in Kilworth Church-yard.
 Colonel R. K., and Mr. B. were
 were with his Lordship, but not present when
 the shot was fired.—The Earl and Colonel are
 gone off to the Lord Lieutenant, and from thence
