WHEREAS We have received Information. that the Lord Chancellor's Steward, of the Name of ALLEN, was, on Thursday Night last, most inhumanly Murdered by a number of Perfons, who are supposed to have entered by a Ladder into his Bed-Chamber, at his Lordship's House, at Mount-Shannon, in the County of the City of Limerick, from whence the Perpetrators of this horrid Crime dragged him, the faid ALLEN, nearly a Quarter of a Mile to the River Mulcaire, where the Body of the deceased was afterwards found, with many marks of Violence thereon.

Now We the Lord Lieutenant and Council of Ireland, being fully determined, as far as in Us lies, to bring the Persons concerned in the faid Murder to speedy and condign Punishment, do hereby publish and declare, that if any Perfon thall, on or before the First Day of March next, discover or apprehend any Person or Perfons concerned in the faid Murder, the Perfon or Persons so discovering and causing the Person or Persons concerned in said Murder to be apprehended, shall receive as a Reward the Sum of TWO HUNDRED POUNDS for each and every of the first three Persons who shall be fo discovered, apprehended, and prosecuted to Conviction for the faid Offence herein before-mentioned.

AND We do hereby further publish and declare, that if any Person concerned in the said Offence shall discover any of his Accomplices concerned therein, fo as fuch Accomplice or Accomplices shall be apprehended and prosecuted to Conviction for faid Offence, such Person or Persons so discovering, shall, over and above the faid Reward, receive His Majesty's most gracious Pardon for the faid Offence, for which he shall so discover and prosecute as aforefaid. And We do hereby firictly charge and com-

mand all Justices of the Peace, Mayors, Sheriffs, Bailiffs, and all other His Majelly's loving Subjects; to be aiding and affilling in apprehending and profecuting to Conviction the Persons concerned in the faid Offence.
