BERLIN, Dec. 18 - Their Majesties, with the King's brothers and all their fuite, are arrived here to-day from Portfdam.

When the Grand Bailli had Snifhed his fpeech be presented to the First Conful a law of the Valefian Diet, in the following terms:-

REPUBLIC OF THE VACAIS. The Diet of the Republic, on a conflictuional that it is the firft Diet which has affembled, in virtue of the Treaties and Confliention, which have restored to the Valesiane their independence, &c. &c. decrees :

Art. I. Bonaparte, First Confel of the French Republic, and President of the Italian Republic, is proclaimed in name of the Valelian people, reflorer of the independence of the Republic of the Valais.

II. The homage of the prefent law shall be conveyed to him by a special Deputation.

III. The prefent law shall be printed, published, and paised up every year on the 5th of September, the anniversary of the proclamation of the independence of the Value,
