Pichegru.—Although the London papers received this day, are filent as to fuch a fact, our private correspondent, who is possessed of the first sources of information, states that General Pichegru in Paris, and is airested by the French Gottenment. This circumstance would seem to establish the truth of a conspiracy against Bonaparte, but, if Moreau was concerned in it, it also proves that it must have had the concurrence of some of the best men in France, and of those who had tendered it the greatest service.
