LIMERICK, MARCH

A letter from Portarlington, says "A great conspiracy has been discovered in the King's County; this morning a list of names of the conspirators passed through this town, with orders to send them all to the Castle."

About seven o'clock on Saturday evening, Mr. Maher, of Castle Connel, returning home to the City, was stopped at Newcastle, by a party of robbers, with pistols, who robbed him of 3 guineas and 10 shillings in notes, and his watch; in an attempt to resist the robbers they beat him in the most cruel manner.

Yesterday, Michael Ryan, working in a boat at Sir Harry's-Quay, fell into the River, and was carried by the current under Baal's-Bridge, where he sunk twice, but rising at George's-Quay, a man, Edw. O'Shaughnessy, a journeyman, careless of the unusual severity of the weather, and regardless of his own life, but feelingly alive to the relief of a fellow creature, jumped into the water, and brought on shore the drowning man. An Officer of the 45th Regt. passing by at the same time, humanely purchased a pair of new blankets, and with which he had the poor man rolled up, and notwithstanding that and every other assistance given to the unfortunate man, he died in a few hours. We are sorry to observe that there is no establishment in this City, to reward those who save the lives of others;—but we trust it is only a matter of time to call on every benevolent Citizen to their Subscription, as an approval of the generous deed of Edward O'Shaughnessy.
