His Majesty has been pleased to promote the

procured a Corporal's guard, went in quest of the
murderers, and apprehended Patrick Riedy, John
Mahony, and William M'Nema;—the latter has
been liberated—Riedy and Mahony are committed
to the City Gaol, by the Right W^{orshipful} Mayor.

Yesterday the Mayor, held an inquest on the
body of the above deceased, whose verdict was—
Wilful Murder.

Yesterday morning a Barn, belonging to Patrick
Gleeson, Farmer, near Gillogue, adjoining the
Canal, was accidentally burned down, occasioned
by Flax being drying therein.

This day the Right Worshipful Arthur Vincent,
Esq; Mayor, was determined to finish his Magis-
tralty by an act of mercy;—which was by liberating
a Carpenter of the name of Michael Comerford
who had been convicted before him in a summary
manner, of Combination, and sentenced to 6 months
imprisonment, three of which were unexpired.
