## LIMERICK, OCTOBER 6.

Monday last, a Boy of 12 years of age, was drowned in the river at Rathkeal.

The Post Boy conveying the Mail from Waterford to this city, was robbed on Wednesday morning, at Kilfeacle, within two miles of Tipperary.

Thursday last, the Rt. Hon. Countess of Clare, set off from Mount Shannon, for Dublin.

Wednesday evening, Ann Manning was brought in and lodged in the City Gaol, by a guard of the 25th Regiment, charged with the murder of Mary Doherty, on the 19th of September last, at Courtbrack, near this City. She was apprehended by the party of said Regt. quartered at Patrick's Well.

On Thursday night, at so early an hour as seven o'clock, Mr. Joseph Ryan, Victualler, returning from a Fair, with Cattle, to this City, was attacked on the high road, nearly opposite the Race ground at Newcastle, by three Men, armed with a blunderbuss and pistols, who repeatedly struck him on the head till he fell to the ground, when they robbed him of his hat, watch, and 2s. 6d. in cash.—In less than an hour after, Michael Hickey, of Stradbally, Farmer, going from Limerick to his abode, was attacked at the same place, by five villains, supposed to be of the above gang, one of whom was armed with a blunderbuss, the others with pistols, after knocking down Hickey, they demanded his money, when they robbed him of 10 Guineas, and a Bank Silver Token for 6s.
