By Letters from Ceylon, dated 20th February last, hostilities still continued against the King of Candy, and frequent skirmishes took place between our troops and his. It was supposed when reinforcements arrived, which were soon expected, that something decisive would be accomplished against that treacherous enemy. At the above date, Captain Rumley was still alive, at Candy. General Home had just arrived at Madras, and was expected at Ceylon, to take on him a command at that Island.

The County of Limerick is to furnish 125 men, as its quota for supplying the vacancies that have arisen in the Army of Reserve, and 37 deficient of the original complement, making in all to be provided against the first of next month 162 Men.

The City of Limerick is to furnish 93 men, which with 59 deficient of the original quota, making in the whole 152 men, to be raised against the first of next month.
