

Saturday night last, a gang of ruffians to the  
 number of five or six, who were employed on the early  
 part of the day in digging potatoes in the neighbour-  
 hood of the town, attacked a Carman on the road,  
 from whom they robbed of small Bank  
 notes to the amount of twenty shillings:—they  
 then proceeded to the Cross of Jockey-Hall, where  
 they met another Carman of the name of Danaher,  
 whom they likewise attacked;—but he, being a  
 resolute and brave man, aided by his brother, resisted  
 them, and gave one of the gang, named Michael  
 Barry, a blow on the head, which knocked him into  
 the car, with whom they drove off to Mr. Roche,  
 of Carass, a Magistrate for this County, who safely  
 lodged him in Croom Bridewell. He has since  
 been identified as the person who robbed the first  
 mentioned Carman.

Thursday evening Thomas Gough, of Tuoreen,  
 South Liberties, of this City, Esq; died sud-  
 denly whilst at dinner in his lodgings, Mary-Street;  
 his death is much lamented by connexions and ac-  
 quaintance the most respectable.
