Just as this Paper was going to Press, we receiv-
ed an account, that a few nights since, the house
of Mr. Thos. Grubb, at Kilgeany, near Clonmel,
was maliciously burned to ashes by a number of
villains.

By a Letter from Waterford, dated March 12,
we learn, a detachment of 45 men of the Kerry
Militia, quartered in that City, marched under the
command of Capt. Twiss, at 10 o'clock the pre-
ceding night, to Annstown, about ten miles from
Waterford, to take possession of a Spanish Ship,
named the Sampson, driven ashore, laden with
rum, sugar, coffee, &c. prize to the Melpomene
Frigate.—The crew were all saved and most of
the cargo, but the vessel is become a wreck.
