The substance of the Three Packets which arrived since our last, being peculiarly interesting, and our wish to please our numerous Friends unceasing, we have this day given a large Supplement, containing the Remarks of the Chancellor of the Exchequer, on opening the Irish Budget; and we have to congratulate the public, the new taxes are but few, and such as we believe will press but very lightly on the less opulent of this Country.

We hear it is intended by the Irish Government immediately to have two encampments formed on a very extensive scale, the one at Cork, the other on the Curragh of Kildare.

The Post Masters General have been pleased to order three additional Posts weekly, to be established to Rathkeale, and a Post twice a week to Scarriff.

Monday last, the drowned body of Stephen Lacey, Carpenter, was taken out of the Canal;—he had been missing nearly three weeks.
