

At the commencement of our Assizes, the following persons have been capitally convicted:—
In the County Court, John H. Ryan, for robbing a Post-boy of the Mails, which he was conveying from our Post Office to Rathkeale, &c. on the night of the 6th of January last, near Croagh.—
In the City Court, John Freeze, for the murder of his Wife, a Cloondrina, (North Liberties,) on the night of 23d of March, 1804; the Hon. Baron McClellan in a most impressive and feeling manner, passed the awful sentence of the law on Freeze, and ordered him for execution to-morrow, and his body to be given for dissection.
