Dr. Lindsay's conduct, since his appointment to the See of Kildare, has been truly laudable, and has, in two instances, evinced that wisdom and benevolence which must secure to him the affection of all ranks of people. In the first place, he has humanely parcelled out the Church Demesne into small lots, not exceeding 4 Acres each, which have been set to the Industrious Poor of Kildare, considerably under value, whereby between 20 and 30 families have been rendered comfortable in their situations; and secondly, he has entirely rejected those instruments of oppression, Tythe Farmers, and has taken, as it were, the Proprietor of the Soil, under his own immediate protection.
