chosen, will restore a convenience to the ancient
parts of the City, from which it has been long re-
moved ;—and, in consequence of the Mail Coach
driving past the door of the Office, a much earlier

are informed, from good authority, that so much
was it the wish of the Post-Mistress to settle the
Office near the Commercial Buildings, that she had
consented to pay a very heavy rent, far exceeding
the limits of her official allowances, provided the
Public would accommodate her with a chosen house
on such terms ; but this offer of private sacrifice to
public benefit, not being accepted, but by a few in-
dividuals, she has been obliged to fix on the present
house, and from which much advantage is likely to
arise, without any inconvenience, except to a few,
who are removed too far for the reach of any public
office ; and the very early arrival of the Mails will
render such very trifling indeed, even to those.
