rough but badly accommodated to the tender foot of a lemale, would afford wholesome exercise and air, were it not that its banks are constantly crowded by naked Men, who, shameless in themselves, spare not the unprotected Female who comes within their reach. The exertion of the Magistrates (never wanted when called on) would, by a decisive, determined pursuit of those who presume to bid deciance to all order and decency, put a stop to such practice; and when such exertions have had the desired effect, they will be rewarded by the Thanks and warm approbation of their FEMALE FELLOW CITIZENS.

Early on Sunday morning, the Lady of William Maunsell, of Dominick-street, Esq; was safely delivered of a daughter, but in about an hour afterwards the Mother was taken suddenly ill, and melancholy to relate, almost instantaneously her numerous offspring, the dear Partner of her bosom, and the most respectable and extensive connexions and acquaintance, were deprived of the society and friendship of this amiable young lady, who, in the bloom of life, died, to the inexpressible grief of all.

On Monday last, Mr. Steph.
