## LIMERICK—JUNE 8.

Very considerable improvements are intended to be made in the Custom-House Docks of this Port, for the greater convenience and accommodation of shipping. The works commenced yesterday, and we have no doubt they will be completed soon as possible.

On Monday, a Troop of the 23d Light Dragoons, commanded by Colonel Lumley, marched into Clonmel from Kilkenny; two Troops more are expected, they are to remain there to do Garrison duty.

Since Monday last, a General Court Martial, of which Brigadier-General Mitchell is President, and Capt. Stone, of the Londonderry Regiment, Judge Advocate, has been sitting by prorogation, in the County Grand Jury Room, for the trial of Michael M'Namara, a Private in the 18th Lt. Dragoons, charged with striking an Officer in said Regt. William Taylor, a Private in the Royal Artillery, is to be tried by said Court.

Yesterday the Right Worshipful Robert Briscoe, Esq; Mayor, Fined the Englishtown Scavengers 5s. 5d. for a neglect in their Servants, which Fine he ordered to the Poor in the House of Industry. As his Worship is known not to be a Respector of PERSONS, we hope he will further add to the Funds of that Charity, by laying a Tax on the Herd of SWINE which infest our streets, and are, at least, as great a nuisance.
