Merchants, Bankers, Traders, and principal inhabitants of Cork, entertained His Grace and Suite at a grand Dinner on Sunday Evening, Sir Patrick O'Connor presiding. The night was spent with the utmost conviviality. On Monday, Right Hon. Colonel Vereker, M. P. arrived here, and next morning proceeded for London to attend a Privy Council, which was to be held on Monday yesterday.

Right Hon. Lord Chief Baron set off from his seat at Mount Prospect, in this Co. for the like purpose. Orders have been issued for the Yeomanry Brigade to parade with the Troops in George's-Street, in the morning, on Sunday next, dressed in full uniform, with arms, accoutrements, and every thing in the best possible order, for inspection by His Majesty's Commissioner, Sir James Affleck, Bart.

Understand Gen. Affleck has signified his wish, to see the parade of the City Yeomanry with the troops, on every Sunday.
