On the night of the 21st inst prodigious flashes of lightming shot across the Rostrevor mountains. By one of these a solid rock of granite, probably about eight tons in weight, was rent into pieces. One fragment plesented the appearance of a flag, of about a hundred weight. The remainder was shattered into atoms.
