On Monday last an inquest was taken before
Aldermen Watson and Marrett, on the body of
Joseph Bently, (who died early that morning in

circumstances relating to his illness, when after a
deliberate investigation of two hours, and the
examination of several witnesses by an intelligent
Jury, the following verdict was returned, viz:—

“The deceased came by his death in consequence
of a severe beating received by him from a person
who has since absconded.”

Saturday night, two men named Molony and
Divane, were detected disposing of two small bags

by a person of the name of John Cross an under
clerk in their employment.—Cross and Molony
have been committed to jail, and Divane having

The house of Mr. Goold, pawn-broker, Sir

Monday morning at five o'clock, the shop of Mr.
James O'Dea, cloth merchant, Charlotte's Quay,
was broken open, and a robbery endeavoured to
be effected—one of the shutters having been pierced
by a small augur in several places, about two feet
of it was sawed off in the most ingenious manner,
and a pane of glass put out, when a young fellow
entered the shop, and packed up a small bundle of
linen with which he was making off, but being dis-
covered by the watchman, he left the parcel, and,
we regret to say, made his escape. As no person
slept in the lower part of the house, the circum-
stance was not known, until the watchman alarmed
the family.
