On the night of the 8th inst. a person named Ryan was found dead in the street of Galbally, in this County. An inquest was held at the time by C. Bennet, Eaq. Coroner, and there did not appear any evidence of violence; but it is now ascertained that he was murdered, and two persons have abscended, and a third is in custody.

A clue has recently been discovered, leading to all the circumstances of the atrocious and panatural murder of John Ryan, at Ballyvorneen, near Cahirconlish, in October last. This clue has, within those few days, been rendered more clear and satisfactory, attaching the strongest guilt to four persons now in prison for the crime, and for whose conviction the fullest proof is in preparation.
