Yesterday morning, at a very early hour, the dwelling of Mr. Gabriel Fisher, at Courtrack, in the South Liberties, was burglariously entered by three ruffians, who demolished one of the windows and robbed Mr. Fisher of his watch, carried off a quantity of bacon, with some wearing apparel and money. The Police at Ballinacurra having been apprised of the attack, hastened to the spot, but the ruffians had effected their retreat a few moments before their arrival, and no clue has yet been found likely to lead to their discovery.

On Thursday night, while the family was in Cashel, a gang of armed ruffians, with their faces blackened, entered the house of Ivory Jordan, Esq. at the Race-Course, near Cashel, and plundered it of all the fire-arms, some small change in silver, some articles of plate, drank some and spilled a good deal of spirits, &c. which was in the cellar, and injured a great part of the furniture.

On Monday night the cabin of a man of the name of Richard Hanrahan, at Glenaskough, near Nine-mile-House, was entered and robbed of what wearing apparel or other necessaries the poor people had, by some armed marauders, who also beat Hanrahan's wife in an unmerciful manner.—Same night a pedlar was robbed near the spot.

A soldier of the 3d Light Dragoons, of the name of Proctor, fell out of a cot in the Erne river and was drowned on Sunday evening last.

John Molony, a cart-maker, dropped dead yesterday morning, in Mungret-street, while at his work. The Mayor held an inquisition on the body—verdict "died by the visitation of God."

A noted character, Val. Ryan, from the neighbourhood of Nenagh, has been apprehended by the activity of Lieut. Pepper and two of his Police. He has been concerned in several robberies in Lower Ormond.

Four convicts from the County Longford arrived here on Monday, and yesterday were forwarded to the hulk at Cove.

The Court of King's Bench, on Monday, refused to set aside the non-suit in the case of Mangin v. the Allion Insurance, tried here at last Assizes. The conditional order for a new trial obtained by plaintiff, was set aside, with costs.

In the case of Jamieson against O'Callaghan, reported in our last, the Jury not having agreed to a verdict at three o'clock, were discharged by the Mayor.

A scarcity of potatoes will very soon be felt in Ennis, as the supply is not adequate to the demand; the price has already reached five pence halfpenny the stone.

We should be glad to find, that Oatmeal became more the diet of the poor—it is now selling at three pence a pottle.

A quantity of potatoes and cabbages seized yesterday by the Mayor, from standings impeding the public streets, were distributed at the Exchange to indigent room-keepers.
