Government has offered a reward of £200 for the murderers of Philip Quinlan, who was stoned to death near Ulla, on his way home from this City, a few days since.

A Rock notice posted at Doon, near Bilboa, in this County, threatening the life of the agent under the Courts to the property of the late Mr. Marshall, of Timoline, has been removed by the Police. Another incendiary notice was posted at Ballybrood, threatening any persons that would dare offer for certain lands out of lease in that part of the country.

At the fair of Pallis Grean, on Monday, a riot arose and a desperate rencontre took place between two hostile factions, the Maras and Buckleys, wherein one man, Rody Buckley, bog-ranker to Captain Lloyd, of Towerhill, was killed. Michael Connors, a principal in the fight, and subsequent homicide, has been since apprehended by Mr. Richard Ingram, of the Peace Preservation Police.

Eight female convicts from Ennis gaol, arrived here on Monday, under an escort of the 69th Regiment, and proceeded on their route for the convict hulk at Cove, previous to transportation. The cavalcade displayed a most grotesque spectacle in the streets, as some of the women wept most pitiably, while others were laughing outright.

Yesterday the Mayor held an inquest upon the body of John Collins, at the Mayor's Stone, who it appeared had been rolled over by a brewer's dray. The Jury adjourned to this day, when their verdict will be given.

Daniel Minahan, fell into the long dock on Saturday evening and got a very bad compound dislocation of the ankle joint, the large bone forming the instep having been forced outside the skin, was of necessity removed. He is an inmate of the Barrington Hospital and City Infirmary.

A Terry Alt manuscript notice was seen affixed to the gate of the Police Office, Henry-street, yesterday morning, menacing Thomas P. Vokes, Esq. and a Serjeant of that establishment, with the fate of the late Major Going. This vile manifesto was signed Lady Alt.
