The discovery made of the property was most extraordinary, by Sub-constable Patrick Fitzgerald, of the Peace Preservation force at Ballingarry, from the contrivance made for its concealment, a large hole having been dug in the kitchen floor near the fire-place, at least four feet deep, with a tub placed therein, the skin underneath, and the meat salted in the tub, a cradle with a child in it was regularly over the spot; the policeman removed the cradle, and observing the ground underneath fresh, was fortunate to find the stolen property below.
