Constable Ryan and his party at Patrick's-well, assisted
by Major Vokes's Peace Preservation Police, succeeded in
apprehending James Lee on Sunday last, for the murder of
Matthew Mullins in this city, in the month of January last.

An inquest was held yesterday at Barrington's Hospital by
the Mayor, on an elderly man whose name is unknown. He
had the dress of a countryman, and rather remarkable ap-
pearance, having lost all the front teeth in the upper jaw at
the left side, and the remaining ones very large and obtrud-
ing. He was of rather low stature, delicate figure, and of
mean attire. He fell into the Long Dock about 12 o'clock
at night, was taken up shortly after, but the vital spark had
fled.—Verdict—"We find that an unknown man was acci-
dentally drowned the night of the 31st August, by falling
into the dock near Merchant's-quay."

A man of the name of James Dolan fell from a loft in his
lodging at Shannon-street, on Sunday morning, and died a
few minutes after of rupture of a blood vessel in the head,
caused by the injuries he received.

The Pawn-Office of Mr. John Mullock, George's-Quay,
was secretly entered by one of the front windows on Satur-
day night, when the adventurers succeeded in conveying
away several watches and other property deposited there on
loan. The robbery was not discovered until next morning.
One man is since in custody on suspicion.

Friday night, a young man named John Herrick, residing
on the lands of Iscer, returning from the market of Banagher,
when within half a mile of that town, and about 50 perches
from the Tower police station, he was wantonly and inhu-
manly murdered, having been stabbed through the head, and
his legs and arms broken in several places. There are five
or six persons in custody for this atrocious deed, three of
whom are named Dolan, out of whose house the weapons
for the murder were taken.
