Wednesday, Thursday, and yesterday, Mr. Commissioner Farrell has been sitting in the Record Court for discharge of Insolvent Debtors in this City and County. The petitions of the following City debtors were dismissed as unworthy the benefit of the Act—John Griffin, Michael Hanrahan, James Ward, Richard Meade, Patrick Collins, John White, and Michael Collins. The others on the same list were discharged.—The following persons were heard in the County, and discharged:—Michael Copps, John Cunningham, Edw. Falahy, Catherine Mulcahy, John Mulcahy, Richard Shea, John Grady, James Connell, John Shaughnessy, Edward Fitzgibbon, and Garrett Rourke. The petitions of Michael M'Every, Micheal Keave, Michael Donohue, William Ryan, Daniel Mara, Patrick M'Namara, and James Piper, were dismissed by the Court.

The report of Master Connor, finding that Daniel Barrington, Esq. is a fit and proper person to be appointed Receiver of the Mitchelstown or Kingston estates, was this week confirmed by the Chancellor.

Yesterday the Mayor, Aldermen Mahony, Watson, and Piercy, and William Roche, Esq. M. P. assembled in the Tholsel Court, pursuant to notice, to revise the Jurors' list, before transferring it to the hands of the Sheriffs. Not above six objections were tendered to the Magistrates from persons claiming the legal exemption from serving, and none from the Society of Friends.

The Mayor yesterday held an Inquest at the County Hospital on the body of John O'Brien, who died of injuries he received from Thomas Birnane, James Griffin, and others, at the fair of Caherconlish on Monday last. Verdict—Wilful Murder.

Seven or eight large stacks of oats, the property of Luke White, Esq. have been burned at Rathcline, county Longford.

James Griffin, beat at the fair of Caherconlish on Monday last, has a bad fracture of the scull, and is not likely to recover. Michael Casey, beat at the same fair, suffers from concussion of the brain.

Daniel Hogan (broker) was waylaid at the Blackboy pike, and beat with stones—he has got two bad fractures in the back of his head.

On the night of the 4th inst., twelve sheep, the property of John Myles, Esq. of Rocville, near Castleisland, were stolen by six men, three of whom have been apprehended. Above twenty sheep have been stolen in that neighbourhood since September, independent of those belonging to Mr. Myles.

John Beatty was murdered last week near Creggs, county Galway.

The gentleman, who died suddenly at the Fermoy race meeting last week, was Alexander M'Donnell, Esq. of Springfield, Mayo, an individual of most amiable manners, and prepossessing qualities. The remains of this much esteemed young gentleman were interred at Castle Hyde, Fermoy.
