His Excellency the Lord Lieutenant has been pleased to present the Rev. Maurice Hewson, of Finuge, county Kerry, to the valuable Rectory and Vicarage of Corkbeg, county of Cork, and diocese of Cloyne.

Sub-constables Fleming and Lyons succeeded in arresting Morgan Ahern, on the 16th instant, at the lands of Rahard, in this County, who is charged with a murder committed 12 months since, in Tipperary.

Police Constable Ahern and Sub-Constable Burke were on patrol at Ballyneety, on Friday night, and apprehended Jeremiah Connors, charged with being concerned in a murder at the last fair of Cahirconlish.

The notice was signed Terry Alt, and after reminding him of a caution given the 12th Inst. threatened to bring his coffin to the bed side if he did not banish a person in his service, whom the writer designated an abandoned spy.
