Sunday last, a row-boat, carrying a lug-sail, in which five young lads had embarked on a pleasure party, was run down by a turf boat coming up the river near Tervoe, in full sail. Ropes were flung out, and four of the boys were taken up, but the fifth, James Delany, a pawn-broker's clerk, although keeping himself over water above 10 minutes by swimming, unfortunately perished.

Saturday last, a man of the name of Michael Molony, was found drowned in the Pool, having it appears come to town from Newmarket-on-Fergus in March last, to see friends who were embarking for America. Since that period the man was not seen, until some fishermen found his dead body on the slob near Clonmacken, where the receding tide left it. The Mayor held an inquest upon the deceased—Verdict, found drowned.

Inflammatory placards were posted throughout the city on Monday morning, to intimidate persons from bidding at a Sheriffs' sale, of the interest of a man of the name of Lynch, in certain lands at Mungret, which were in debt for tythe. A great crowd, of course, was collected, but a sale took place notwithstanding.

Thomas P. Vokes, Esq. has been so fortunate as to secure the original plate from which so many forgeries of the Bank of Ireland were struck off, number 23967, for 30s. each, and for uttering which John Pollon formerly an officer in the Army, was found guilty at last Ennis Assizes, and James Johnson, at our City Assizes.

Serjeant John Hourigan and party, of Mr. Vokes' Police, stationed at Loughill, arrested at Foynes' Island, Edmond and Patrick Atkison, ropemakers, from Pennywell, near this City, charged with wantonly and maliciously assaulting James Lynch, Daniel Collins, and Daniel Driscoll, at their work on the Canal while in the employment of the Limerick Navigation Company.

Tuesday night a number of country people assembled on the mountain of Curraghmore, co. Tipperary, the property of John Joseph Henry, Esq. and dug up half an acre of land. They left a notice nailed to Thomas Ryan's door, threatening the inmates with immediate death if they did not return to the county Limerick, they also broke his windows, and fired a shot on their departure.

Yesterday, a girl of the name of Donoghue was transmitted from this City by Thomas P. Vokes, Esq. to Galway, charged with various robberies in that town, and also in Gort.

Sunday morning last, two men got into the office of Messrs. Cummins and Brothers, Merchants, Patrick's-quay, Cork, where they broke open an immense iron safe, taking thereout £35 in notes, silver, dollars and copper.

Corkery, a carpenter, who broke into and robbed the office of Mr. Bennett, Beasley-street, Cork, is sentenced to 7 years' transportation, by the Deputy Recorder of that City.

Driscoll and Long, journeymen bakers, under sentence of death at Cork, are respited to the 2d of May.
