The Postmaster-General has acceded to the request of the Chamber of Commerce of this city, to run the mail hence to Dublin at the rate of nine and a-half British miles per hour, after the 5th July next.

Andrew Maher, a young man in the employment of Mr. Robinson, provision merchant, was yesterday inserting the blade of a store knife into a handle, when he imprudently leant over the point of the blade, which entered his abdomen and inflicted so deep a wound that a large portion of intestines escaped! The man was conveyed to Barrington's Hospital, where Surgeons Thwaites and Franklin immediately attended him. Although in great danger, yet from his youth the chances of surviving the dangerous casualty are rather in his favour.

A miserable wretch of the name of David Duhig, was conveyed to Hospital on Monday night, in a state of insensibility, from drinking to excess of spirituous liquors, and died of the pernicious effects yesterday morning. It appears he had followed the reel of dissipation for a week. What a preparation for eternity!

Thursday morning, Ellen Moore, an elderly woman, was upset by a horse and car in Crosbie-Row, when the wheel of the vehicle passed over her body, and she died in less than an hour from the injuries. The horse escaped in full gallop from Fitt's brewery with a load of grains, the owner, Patrick Quilligan, a Park man, having incautiously left the animal's head, to complete his loading. The Mayor held an inquest on the poor woman—Verdict, accidental death, and the Jury pronounced a deodand of 20s. on the horse and car.
