Sunday morning last, at an early hour, a dispute took place in Fish-lane, off Mary-street, between Edmond Kiely and John Hayes, labouring men, and brothers-in-law, when the former struck the latter a deadly blow, on the head with a stool, which left him senseless on the ground, and being removed in two hours after to Barrington's hospital he expired from the effects of the injury. Constable Philips, and Acting Constable Campbell, shortly after arrested Kiely, and lodged him in the city gaol. The Mayor held an inquest in the afternoon, when the jury returned a verdict "that Hayes came by his death in consequence of the injury inflicted on him by Kiely."
