tim., and threatened to shoot any man who should
interpose. Jeremiah M'Carthy, a principal in this
outrage, has absconded. Collins was brought into
hospital yesterday.

On Tuesday, William Morrison, a servant belong-
ing to a farmer of the name of Cregan, near New-
castle, went to the bog for a load of turf, and when
returning the horse fell on his side, and the ear turned
over on Morrison, who was killed on the spot. An
inquest was held on the body, verdict, accidental
death. It appeared the car was upset by some rub-
