**COMBINATION.**—Captain White, J. P. with Sub-  
Inspector Gun, Head-Constable Condon, and a party  
of Constabulary, proceeded on Wednesday night to  
a public-house in the South Main-street, Cork,  
kept by a man named Sexton, and rushed up  
stairs. On the door of the front room, they  
found two men placed as a guard to prevent entrance.  
However, the police forced in their way and dis-  
covered five men sitting in council. On the table  
were documents books, &c. which were instantly  
taken possession of. The men were arrested, with  
the two others outside the door, and lodged in bride-  
well. On making strict search in the room, the seal  
of the society was found concealed in the chimney.

**FORESTALLING.**—The Rev. Mr. Rowan, of Tralee,
