

A brisk canvass is going on in consequence of the resignation of John Mark, Esq. Commissioner of Life, St Michael's parish.

Some hundreds a year were heretofore received by the authorities in this city for the manure, but now payment is required to remove the sweepings, caused by the diminished planting of potatoes.

Last night the house of Mr. Charles Connors, provision dealer, not many yards from the Police barrack, Thomondgate, was entered through the window, by robbers, who carried off £10 worth of bacon.

William Griffin, a labourer, died suddenly in Mary-street yesterday.

Thursday evening an accidental fire completely destroyed the dwelling house and furniture of Bellisle, county Clare, the residence of Captain Russell, notwithstanding the exertions of the family domestics and neighbours.

Henry Christie, a young man, carpenter by trade, was crushed to death in Askeaton mill, on Christmas eve, while tightening a screw in the machinery which had got loose.

The greatest imposition is carried on by the carriers of coals from the quays to private houses; in fact, they charge what they please, which should not be the case, if the regulated rates were duly enforced by the local authorities. The carriage of turf has also been raised 2d per kish.

The munificent Lady Headley has distributed this week food, clothing, and money to the poor for several miles around her.
