Yesterday, a court was held to hear Sanitary complaints. Magistrates present—The Mayor, H. Watson, J. Crips, R. Russell, W. Hartigan, W. J. Geary, P. G. Barron, Esqrs. Captain Wood, Royal Artillery, and Dr. Delmege, medical military officer, attended, to point out nuisances near the New Barracks, and summonses were ordered to abate them. Complaints were made on the certificates of Doctors Gore and Carey, against the proprietors of nuisances in Carey's road, Bowles's Place, Keefe's Lane, near St. Michael's church, Prospect Row, Creagh Lane, Dickson's Lane, Island, and Newgate Lane. The magistrates decreed in all the cases, and the court adjourned to Friday.

At the Town-hall, yesterday, Patt Kerby, picking pockets, was sentenced to be whipped and confined.—Eight others for robbery were remanded.

The cholera is extending rapidly through Thomondgate, St. Mary's, St. John's, Boherbuoy, and along the quays. On Monday 41 cases, from 10 to half-past 1 yesterday, 14 deaths; 3 discharged; 95 in hospital. Dr. Gore and Dr. Kane had to open additional wards from the rapid increase of the cases. The Fever Committee have made every arrangement possible to meet the urgent state of circumstances.

The Barrington's hospital report this morning is 31 new cases and 13 deaths after the night.

Dr. Bouchier has resigned the appointment of medical officer of St. John's parish for the treatment of cholera patients, conferred on him by the Sanitary Committee, having found the onerous duties interfere too much with his private practice.

Head Constable Michael O'Sullivan, of Newcastle, died of cholera last night at his lodgings on Arthur's quay, and was buried this morning. Constable William Hamilton, of Abbeyfeale, died of cholera in John's hospital, last night. Head Constable O'Sullivan was a rigid teetotaller, and when urged by the medical officer to take a little brandy to rouse his decaying faculties, protested that if his life were to be the penalty he would not violate his solemn vow to God. This worthy man, and faithful disciple of Father Mathew, died without tasting the spirituous liquid.

John Toomey, Policeman, Castle-connell, died in hospital of cholera yesterday; also Martin Dowling, Policeman, Ballinacurra, the day before.

Mr. William Armstrong, Head Constable of Police at Newmarket-on-Fergus, a very intelligent officer, died on Monday last, after four hours illness of cholera.

Two crown witnesses, a man named Ryan, and a woman named Dineen, who had been attending the county assizes, returned home on Saturday, and died on Sunday of cholera—the former at Galbally, the other at Ballylanders.

It is a remarkable circumstance that no case of cholera has yet occurred in our two crowded gaols.
